

Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Telangana Backward Classes Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society (MJPTBCWREIS), Hyderabad

Information bulletin for admission in to Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Telangana Backward Classes Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society for the academic year 2025-26 in classes 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th (for Backlog vacant seats only).

1. Applications are invited for admissions from BC, SC, ST and OC/EBC candidates for vacant seats in Class 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th (English Medium) State Syllabus for the Academic year 2025-26 in BC Boys and Girls Schools run by Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Telangana Backward Classes Welfare Residential Educational Institutions Society Hyderabad. The entrance exam will be held on 20.04.2025 from 10.00 AM to 12.00 PM at all District headquarters across the State.

2. Eligibility for Admission:

- a) Students seeking admission in Class 6th must have studied in Class 5th in the year 2024-25 in a Government or Government Recognized School in the concerned District.
- b) Students seeking admission in Class 7th must have studied Class 6th in the year 2024-25 in a Government or Government Recognized School in the concerned District.
- c) Students seeking admission in Class 8th must have studied Class 7th in the year 2024-25 in a Government or Government Recognized School in the concerned District.
- d) Students seeking admission in Class 9th must have studied Class 8th in the year 2024-25 in a Government or Government Recognized School in the concerned District.
- e) Students should have studied indefinitely in a Government or Government Recognized School during the academic year 2023-24 and 2024-25.

Income Limit: The annual income of the parents/guardians of the students should not exceed Rs.1,50,000/- for Rural students and Rs.2,00,000/- for Urban students.

3. Admission in to School:

- Erstwhile District is considered as a unit for selection of students.
- For admission into Residential School in the Erstwhile District, student must have studied in any of the Schools in the Erstwhile District.

4. Entrance Test Syllabus: Entrance Test will be conducted in Telugu, Mathematics, Environmental Science (Science and Social Science).

- For Class 6 Entrance Exam, Class 5 Syllabus

- For Class 7 Entrance Exam, Class 6 Syllabus
- For Class 8 Entrance Exam, Class 7 Syllabus
- For Class 9 Entrance Exam, Class 8 Syllabus

Exam will be objective type for 100 marks (Telugu-15, Maths-30, General Science-15, Social Science-15, English-25 marks) in two hours duration.

- Answers should be marked on OMR sheet.
- Sample question paper and sample OMR sheet is given in Table-1.
- The question paper will be in Telugu and English languages.

5. Examination Centre: The entrance exam will be conducted in their own District only. Exam centre details will be given in the hall ticket.

6. Selection Procedure for Admission: Eligible candidates will be selected based on Merit in Entrance Test, Reservation, Special Category (Orphan).

The following Reservation pattern will be followed:

- Date of Birth will be considered if more than one candidate has got equal rank and then considered highest marks obtained in Mathematics and Environmental Science.
- If there are no candidates are available in any reservation category, then such reservation vacancies will be allotted to candidates of next reservation category as per Government rules.
- If any vacancies related to Special Categories (Orphans) remain, such vacancies will be allotted to candidates of next reservation category on merit basis.
- District wise, School wise vacancy details are given in Annexure-2.
- The Society/Institute reserves the right, to refuse admission to selected students who are not eligible for admission.
- The Hall tickets of the students selected for admission will be placed on the institute website <https://mjptbcwreis.telangana.gov.in> or <https://mjptbcadmissions.org> by **15.04.2025**
- SMS will be sent over phone only to shortlisted candidates for admission.
- Admission process will be closed on **31.07.2025**. No correspondence will be allowed after this date.

7. How to Apply:

- After checking the above qualifications and satisfying the candidates, go to any (PAYMENT GATEWAY) Telangana Online with basic details

(Student's Name, Date of Birth, Father/Guardian's Mobile No.) and pay Rs.150/- a journal number will be generated. Just getting the journal number does not mean that you have applied. It is just a number indicating that the application fee has been paid.

- Based on the journal number, the candidate should apply online through any ONLINE/ internet centre by visiting website <https://mjptbcwreis.telangana.gov.in>. or <https://mjptbcadmissions.org>
This journal number should be entered in the space (column) reserved for details of payment of examination fee.
- Online applications can be made from **06.03.2025 to 31.03.2025**.
- After submitting the online application, a reference number will be given and a copy of the filled application form should be taken and kept it for future use.
- Before submitting the application through internet, fill the sample application form, scan it and upload one passport size photograph is required.
- At the time of application, the candidate should have certificates such as Caste, Income, Special Category, Study and Bonafide Certificates, Date of Birth etc. (Original) should be obtained. If not available at the time of application, then they should get the above-mentioned certificates at the time of admission. Original Certificates should be submitted at the time of admission. If not submitted, admission will not be given even if the student is selected.
- Applications sent by directly to the Institute, Society, School and through e-mail will not be considered, other than online. Such candidates will not be allowed to take the exam.
- Hall tickets can be downloaded from any nearest internet/online centre through their reference number 7 days before the exam date.
- Hall tickets will not be sent to the candidates either by post or directly. Download through internet only.
- Applications of ineligible candidates will not be considered.

District wise, Class wise and Category wise vacancy details available in Annexure-2.

- **In which category vacancies are available, only those categories students can apply. Candidates belonging to other categories should not apply. If you do it, it has nothing to do with the organization.**

Age:

- **Class 6:** Age between 10 to 12 years as on 31-08-2025. A relaxation of 2 years is given for SC/ST students.
- **Class 7:** Age between 11 to 13 years as on 31-08-2025. A relaxation of 2 years is given for SC/ST students.

- **Class 8:** Age between 12 to 14 years as on 31-08-2025. A relaxation of 2 years is given for SC/ST students.
- **Class 9:** Age between 13 to 15 years as on 31-08-2025. A relaxation of 2 years is given for SC/ST students.

8. Important instructions for the candidates while filling the online application:

- Before filling the online application, first fill the sample application form.
- Exam Centre should select their own District only.
- Before choosing the school priority order, check and fill the table of schools.
- Keep passport size photograph ready.
- Candidate details should be entered carefully while filling the applications.
- The candidate shall bear full responsibility for any mistakes made in filling the application. No further changes will be made.
- Once the application is uploaded online, no changes are made. So, check all the details before uploading the application.
- Merely appearing in the entrance test does not qualify for admission.
- As per Government orders, reservation will be implemented in allotted seats.
- The students of the respective Districts are eligible for admission in the respective Schools and will not be transferred from one School to another School under any circumstances.
